Dear traveler:

Please take into account and apply for your trip based on the Global Code of Ethics for Tourism of the World Tourism Organization:

Open up to different cultures and traditions of their own: their experience will be transformed, you respect local people win, and it will welcome more easily. Be tolerant and respect diversity; observe the traditions and social and cultural practices of the place. Respect human rights.

Any form of exploitation violates the fundamental objectives of tourism. Child sexual exploitation is a crime punishable in the place where it is carried out as in the country of residence committed by whomever.

Help preserve the natural environment. Protect the flora and wildlife and their habitat, and do not buy products made from endangered plants or animal products.

Respect cultural resources. Tourism activities should be conducted with respect for the artistic, archaeological and cultural heritage, is not tempted to take pieces of archaeological remains, plants, flowers, and others. If every tourist who visited the site, take a sample, would cease to exist very soon the appeal.

Your trip can contribute to economic and social development. Buy local crafts and products to support the local economy, and stick to the principles of fair trade. When haggle, keep in mind the concept of fair wage. Crafts are the most important reflection of the culture and local identity and its profits go directly to the populations of the localities visited.

They are also produced with very low impact on the environment and contribute to increasing the appreciation of local culture. Know the law to not commit any act considered criminal in the country visited.

No traffics in drugs, arms, antiques, protected species and products or hazardous substances or prohibited by national regulations. In case of accidental spill of a product during the tours should not try to control it alone; get help immediately to the authorities or bodies responsible.

Maintain order and cleanliness in the places you visit, avoiding potentiate the various risks that threaten installations and other protected natural area. Do not throw food scraps in the places visited. Take special care in protected natural areas; the remains of fruit may contain seeds that can germinate in place and then become an invasive species harming native species.

Enjoy and respect everything that makes visited destination; a unique and different place: from its history, its architecture and religion to its music, art and cuisine. Keep in mind to close the taps, switch off the air conditioning and lights when you leave the hotel or place of lodging. So, it helps not to waste water and energy, valuable resources for the entire planet. Try to minimize the generation of waste and refuse products with unnecessary packaging as well as choose to use recyclable packaging.
